RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

All Idaho Certificates must be renewed. Application for renewal must be made on forms supplied by the State Department of Education or the Division of Vocational Education. Applications can be made anytime between January 1 and September 30 of the year in which the certificate expires. Certificates shall be renewed by forwarding a completed application packet consisting of the following:

- 1. Proper application and fee.
- Official transcripts verifying a total of at least six semester hours (9 quarter hours) within the five-year period of the certificate being renewed. For Idaho residents only, up to three semester credits (45 clock hours) of approved district-verified inservice participation may apply toward the total requirement of six semester credits.

Educationally related coursework at the 100 level or above which appears on an official transcript from an accredited university (correspondence, independent study and on-campus credits) is accepted. Credits must be verified by official transcripts forwarded with your application and fee to Teacher Certification. Credits may not be held from one renewal period to the next.

Specific conditions for renewing one-year permits and out-ofstate endorsements are printed on the certificate to be renewed.
